

Smith County Youth Expo Speaking Contest Rules

General Rules

1. Speaking contest will be held the Tuesday of the Smith County Youth Expo.
2. Contestants will be required to meet the fundraising requirements set forth to enter the SCYE.
3. Entry Fee: \$20 per prepared speech. Entries must be submitted on the Showman App. Entries are due no later than December 1.
4. Eligible Entries: Speeches are required to be the work of eligible exhibitors - limited to Texas FFA and Smith County 4-H members.
5. Speeches must relate directly to an agricultural topic.
6. Contestants may enter more than one prepared speech. Speeches must be completely different topics. A different speech is defined as:
 - a. All speech material in each manuscript must be entirely different, including the introduction, body and conclusion, which also includes all facts, figures, quotes, titles, etc.
7. Contestants should wear FFA Official Dress or business attire.
8. There will be no speech topic divisions.
9. Judging: Contestants will be scored using the Prepared Public Speaking Rubric attached. Score sheets will be given back at the conclusion of the contest.
10. Awards: Placings will be announced at the Smith County Youth Expo Ribbon Sale on Friday. The Champion and Reserve Champion out of the Junior, Intermediate and Senior Divisions will be recognized and receive awards.

Junior Speech Rules (Grades 3rd - 6th)

1. All general rules apply.
2. Time requirement: 3 - 6 minutes
3. The contest will consist of speech delivery and a 3 minute question period.
4. The written speech must be the original work of the contestant.

Intermediate Speech Rules (Grades 7th - 9th)

1. All general rules apply.
2. Time requirement: 5 - 7 minutes
3. The contest will consist of speech delivery and a 5 minute question period.
4. The written speech must be the original work of the contestant.

Senior Speech Rules (Grades 10th - 11th)

1. All general rules apply.
2. Time requirement: 6 - 8 minutes
3. The contest will consist of speech delivery and a 5 minute question period.
4. The written speech must be the original work of the contestant.
