SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES

The Guidelines listed below have been adopted by the Smith County Youth Expo board.

- 1. The decision of the scholarship committee will be final, and no appeal shall be considered.
- 2. Applicants will be required to attend an interview with a committee. The committee will be appointed by the Board of Directors.
- 3. Applicants are encouraged to wear Official Dress or professional Dress to the interview.
- 4. Interviews will be at a time and location disclosed to all applicants.
- 5. Scholarships MUST be complete and given to SCYE officials in the manner and by the time set forth on the scholarship application.
- 6. Applicants must exhibit a project (animal or agriculture mechanics) a minimum of 2 years at the SCYE.
- 7. Applicants must exhibit a project in his/her senior year to be eligible to receive a SCYE scholarship.
- 8. Applicant must apply for scholarship thru same entity that they enter the SCYE show thru their senior year.
- 9. Applicants must meet all exhibitor entry requirements, including the fundraising requirements for a minimum of 2 years (i.e. coupon book sales).
- 10. To receive the scholarship funds, student must be enrolled in a 2- or 4-year university as a fulltime student, or a trade/technical school in the fall of the year following the show in which the scholarship was awarded. Extenuating circumstances must be approved by the Board of Directors.
- 11. Scholarship winners must provide proof of enrollment via email to the SCYE Secretary and request funds by October 1st of the Fall semester after being awarded a scholarship to receive funds. Students must provide the remit to address of the school's financial office as well as their student ID number.
- 12. These rules cannot be altered or interpreted except by a majority vote of the Board of Directors.
